- Dog mediate rabies via **dog vaccination** campaigns was reconfirmed as the primary strategy to control and prevent rabies, as to stop the rabies disease cycle
- PEP Human rabies vaccination constitutes an additional tool that indicates cost/benefit for prevention and control strategies in rabies endemic regions targeting group populations such as children.
- The continuous Clinical diagnosis of rabies shows the lack of laboratory diagnosis in countries is a limitation. Improved diagnostic, laboratory capacities and surveillance systems in several countries, including data capturing systems (databases) are essential to truly understand rabies burden.
- Communities education and sensibitization are key aspects of prevention. It was evidenced
 how the WRD greatly contributes to this effort and how more and more countries are
 adopting this day for rabies awareness celebration.

Wound washing is life saving! - reminder





- Rabies tools: the blueprint, Stepwise approach, Rabies educators certificate....tools were reviewed, recalling what is out there ready to support rabies capacity building endeavors in the countries.
- The one health strategies proofs to bust the collaboration between human, animal and the
 communities axes to endorse sustainable anti-rabies drive at all levels. Developing a
 comprehensive rabies control/elimination programmed at regional and country levels in
 bottom up approach.
- To pursue rabies control and prevention strategies is necessary **country Investment**, to promote country investment it is necessary to unveil rabies burden
- MEEREB countries due portrait a large and different rabies situation scenarios, this diversity is found in terms status of the disease, geographically including language barriers. Some countries are ready for mayor progress, and some countries poised to progress.
