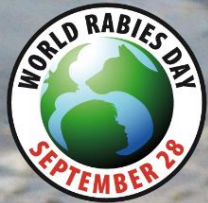

What is World Rabies Day?

- Worldwide annual event every September 28th (Death anniversary of Louis Pasteur)
- To celebrate rabies prevention efforts and unite against rabies
- First global advocacy, education and awareness campaign for rabies
- WRD is a GARC (Global Alliance for Rabies Control) initiative

What is World Rabies Day?

- Organized through a system of global partnership from government to local level

- Endorsed by international human and veterinary health organizations:
 - WHO
 - PAHO
 - OIE
 - World Veterinary Association

World Rabies Day History

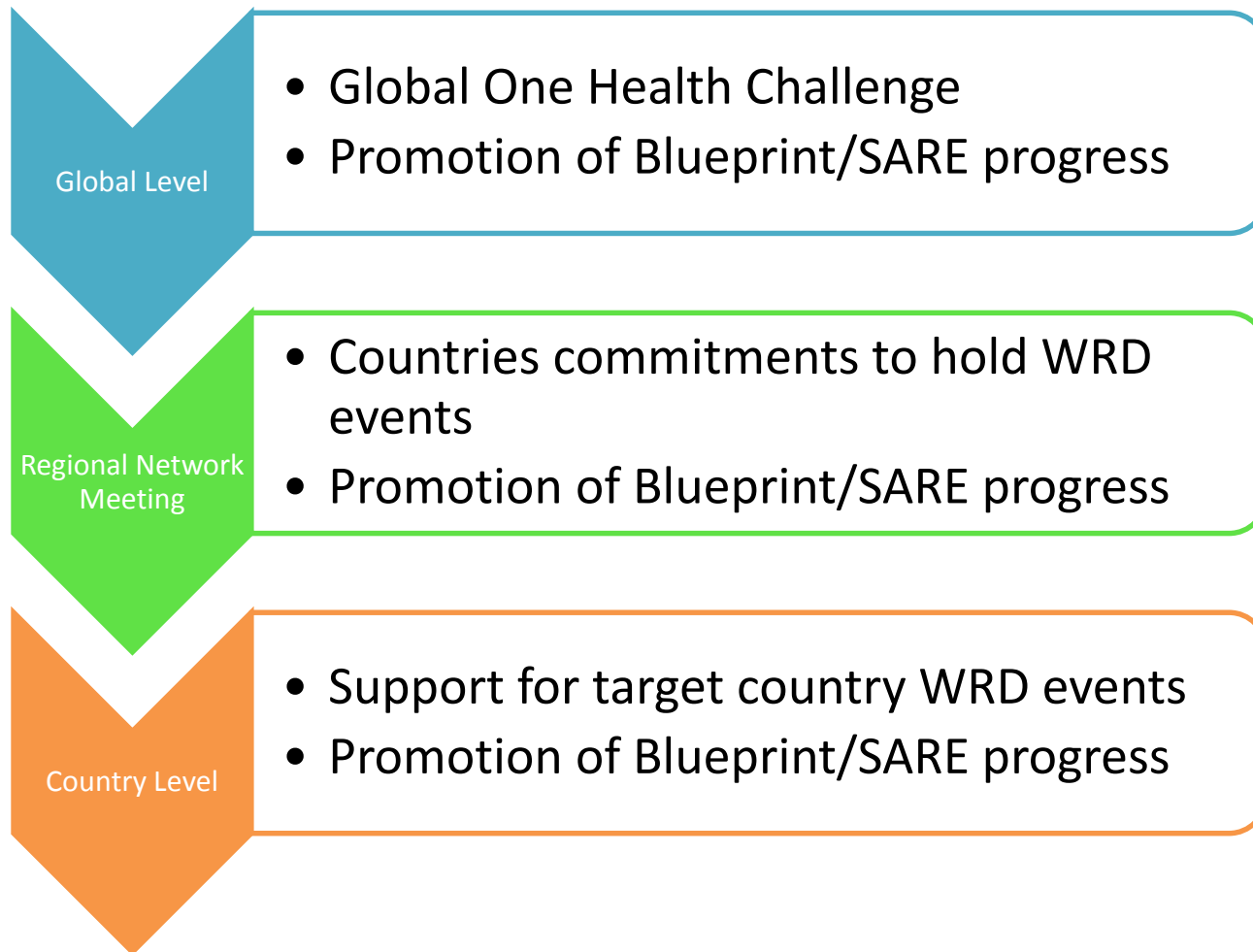
- Since September 2007

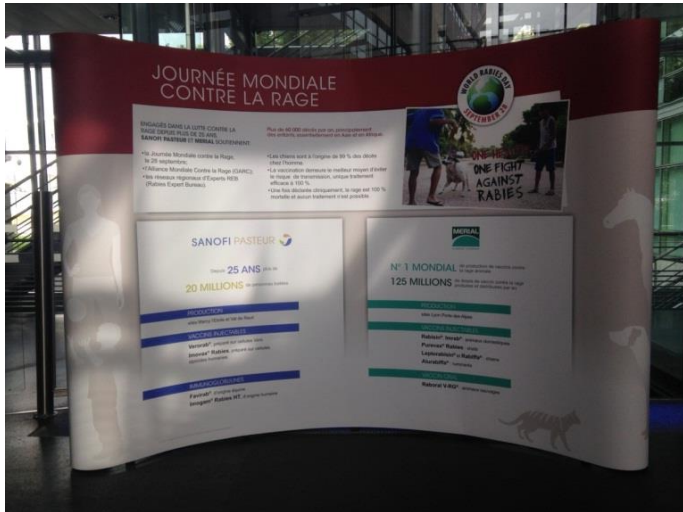

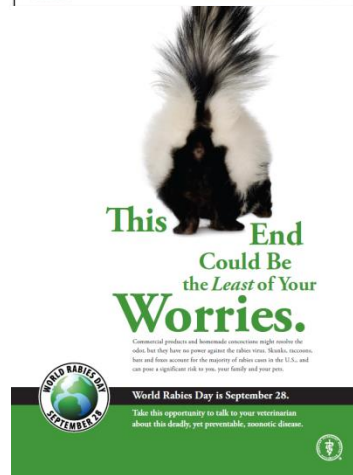

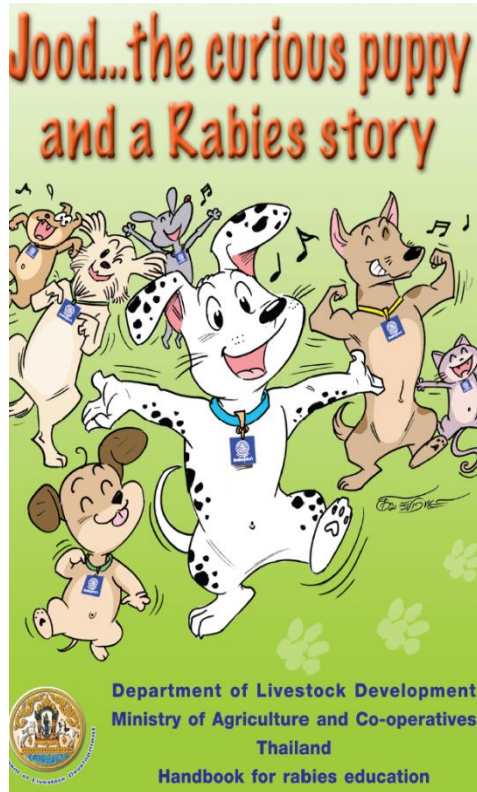

What to do when bitten by a dog or animal



Immediately wash the wound with soap and clean water



Apply Betadine or tincture of iodine to the wound



Consult the nearest doctor for advice on wound treatment and vaccination



Cage and observe the dogs for 10 days (WHO and CDC recommendation)



Immediately consult a veterinarian on what to do with the biting dog



If the dog dies, submit this to the nearest laboratory for rabies examination
