COUNTRY OBJECTIVES FOR THE UPCOMING 3 YEARS

- 1. Generate sufficient data reflecting the burden of disease of influenza in all age group in order to support implementation of influenza vaccination in high-risk patients and high-risk age groups
- 2. Improve awareness and education
- 3. Establish recommendations

- 1. Start and end dates of influenza epidemics: start: 01/11/2016 end: 31/03/2017
- 2. Circulating viruses: A/H3N2, A /H1N1pdm09, B/Yamagata, B/Victoria
