## EPIDEMIOLOGICAL UPDATE

- 1. Start and end dates of influenza epidemics: first week january/ fall february
- 2. Circulating viruses: 60% A/H3 40% B
- 3. Subtypes / lineages: Sequencing in course
- 4. Severity of the epidemics:
  - a) Morbidity (No of reported cases): 220,000 to date (24 th march 2017)
  - b) Mortality (No of reported deaths): 3 SARI cases (all not vaccinated)
