KEY PRINCIPLES

- The development and implementation of Cholera Control Plans are country led and context specific. Prioritisation of interventions will need to be adapted to each setting.
- The GTFCC offers short term technical support to countries for the development of CCPs and long term programmatic support for the implementation and monitoring of activities at country level – this is not an emergency response mechanism.
- Requests for support should be directed to the GTFCC Secretariat who will coordinate with the GTFCC network.
- The GTFCC encourages countries to consider targeting existing funded interventions to cholera hotspots – and not only seek new/additional funding to support cholera control activities.
- This proposed process will be adapted with time building on lessons learnt as the roadmap is rolled out and activities

PROPOSED APPROACH



FORMALIZING COUNTRIES ENGAGEMENT

- Recognize cholera as a national area of concern/priority
- Acknowledge and agree to the principle of three axis of the roadmap
- Perform an initial overview of country specific context – based on the GTFCC guidance “M&E dashboard”/Country page
- Identify objectives and provide a timeline for the development of their CCP – and first milestones
- Demonstrate engagement of all the authorities involved: at least Minister of Health and in charge of Water, if possible elevate under the authority of the Prime Minister/President

PLANNING CCP AND REQUESTING SUPPORT

PLANNING - DEVELOPING A CCP *with GTFCC*

technical support to countries on:

Mapping of cholera hotspots

Development of CCP including situational analysis, prioritization of interventions

Strengthening surveillance

GTFCC support in defining OCV needs and requesting OCV



COUNTRY WORKSHOP: To review and validate CCPs with in country partners.

Focus on capacity building

TECHNICAL REVIEW COMMITTEE

Mandate : to review countries plan and provide feedback to the country with two main objectives:

- ensure the plans are aligned with the strategic axis of the Ending Cholera Roadmap – multisectoral interventions targeting cholera hotspots
- ensure costing for the implementation of the plan is adequate.

The Technical Review Committee will also be responsible for the review of OCV requests

GTFCC GUIDANCE - DEVELOPMENT OF CHOLERA CONTROL PLANS

Country Framework including:

- Country M&E Dashboard – including for situational analysis and survey tool – map gaps in lab capacities and surveillance system
- Mapping of hotspots
- “Packages” of WASH interventions
- “Package” surveillance – interventions to strengthen lab capacity and reporting
- Integration of OCV requests in CCP
