



## RESAOLAB WEST AFRICAN NETWORK OF LABORATORIES 5 objectives:

- Strengthening governance: Supporting national laboratory policies
- Developing continuous training: Enhancing human resources in the lab
- Reinforcing quality: Improving reliability of biomedical tests
- Supporting surveillance: Providing support for epidemiological surveillance and health data management
- Building networks: Sharing expertise and resources through national and inter-country networks

Budget: 8 million euros

Partners: Agence Française de Développement (AFD), Islamic Development Bank, Department of International Cooperation of the Principality of Monaco, Stavros Niarchos Foundation, West African Health Organisation, WHO Regional Office for Africa, the Ministries of Health of the seven member countries

## SUPPORTING THE FRAMEWORK OF ACTION

Roadmap to Cholera Control launched in October 2017

 The Mérieux Foundation joined WHO, the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, WaterAid and other partners to launch a renewed strategy

#### Mérieux Foundation role:

 Provide support to the GTFCC's Operational Platform to help countries and partners implement cholera control/elimination programs

### Activities identified for operational support to control cholera:

- Mobilize GTFCC resources to assist countries in developing/adapting their cholera control programs, and facilitate technical support for their implementation at country level
- Mobilize materials and supplies for cholera control
- Support for the cholera control plan implementation at country level
- Organize the GTFCC working group meetings
- Develop training packages and e-learning programs
