SOME PRINCIPLE RECOMMENDATIONS

IRC COMPOSITION AND APPROVAL PROCESS

- Ensure **multisectoral competencies** in the IRC to be able to factor-in cholera-specific constraints and goals in the evaluation of country applications
- Ensure clarity in the **roles and responsibility** of GTFCC and IRC: GTFCC process to pre-endorse request for OCV as part of an endorsed NCP
- Ensure program / IRC process specific design allowing **fast-track review** and approval of OCV requests (closer to IPV than Measles)
- Ensure IRC approval allows for sufficient **flexibility** for program changes within the space of the approved envelope (e.g. changes in hot-spot, size of target population, epidemic contingencies, etc.)
- Ensure / mandate **EPI involvement** / formal endorsement of the NCP

SOME PRINCIPLE RECOMMENDATIONS

CO-FINANCING

- Leverage Gavi fragility policy flexibility to waive co-financing for **fragile / conflict countries**
- In the program design address the specific issue of countries **transitioning** out of Gavi support between the first and the second campaign (e.g. support for the entire plan)
- Explore alternative **design of co-financing** that, while respecting the co-financing requirement, may reduce the financial burden on the country (e.g. matching co-financing with WASH investments)

SOME PRINCIPLE RECOMMENDATIONS

OTHER FACTORS

- Design one common process with the GTFCC that allows **prioritisation / allocation** of doses across all countries irrespective of status of eligibility for Gavi support taking into account outbreak risks and
- Ensure **CSO involvement** in the plans / implementation and emergency response fully leveraging Gavi financing of CSO platforms
