

## EPIDEMIOLOGY TO TARGET MULTI-SECTIONAL INTERVENTIONS

 Many countries are revising or developing NCPs

- A key element in the process is the epidemiological analysis in order to define priority areas to target interventions
- Cholera hotspots have been identified by several countries
- Different methodologies have been proposed and a review is required
- Monitoring the success of the roadmap will require the use of common indicators



## EARLY DETECTION AND RESPONSE TO OUTBREAKS

- Several national and supra-national epidemics still ongoing:
- Yemen, Somalia, Kenya
- Mozambique, Zimbabwe
- Nigeria, Cameroon, Niger
- Several areas in DRC
- Haiti
- Delays are still observed in the identification and early description of outbreaks
- RDTs, rapid molecular methods
- The understanding of the dynamics often does not happen on real-time
- We require better preparedness and response
- Define areas prone to outbreaks, seasonal patterns
