

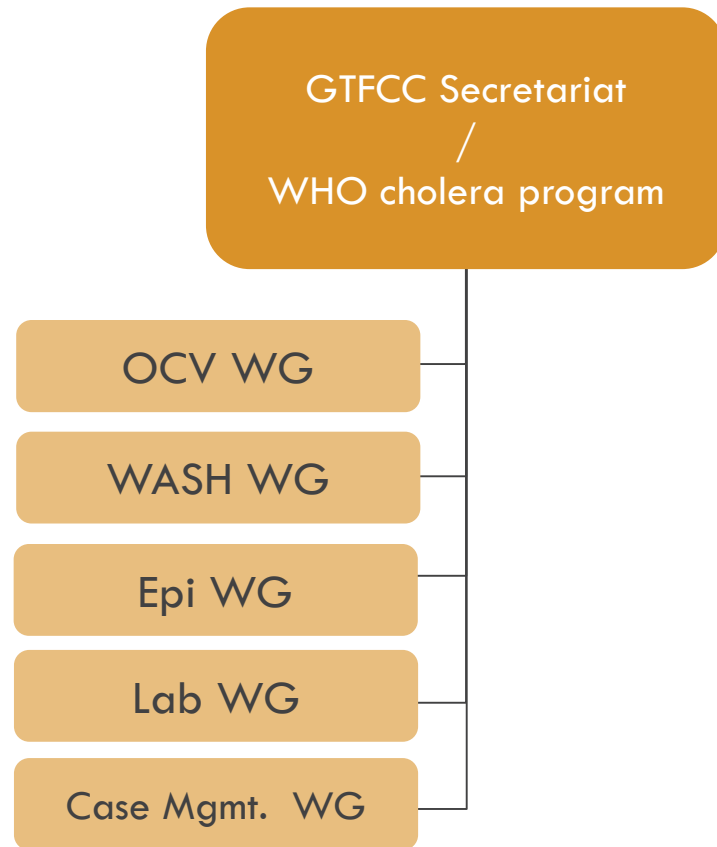

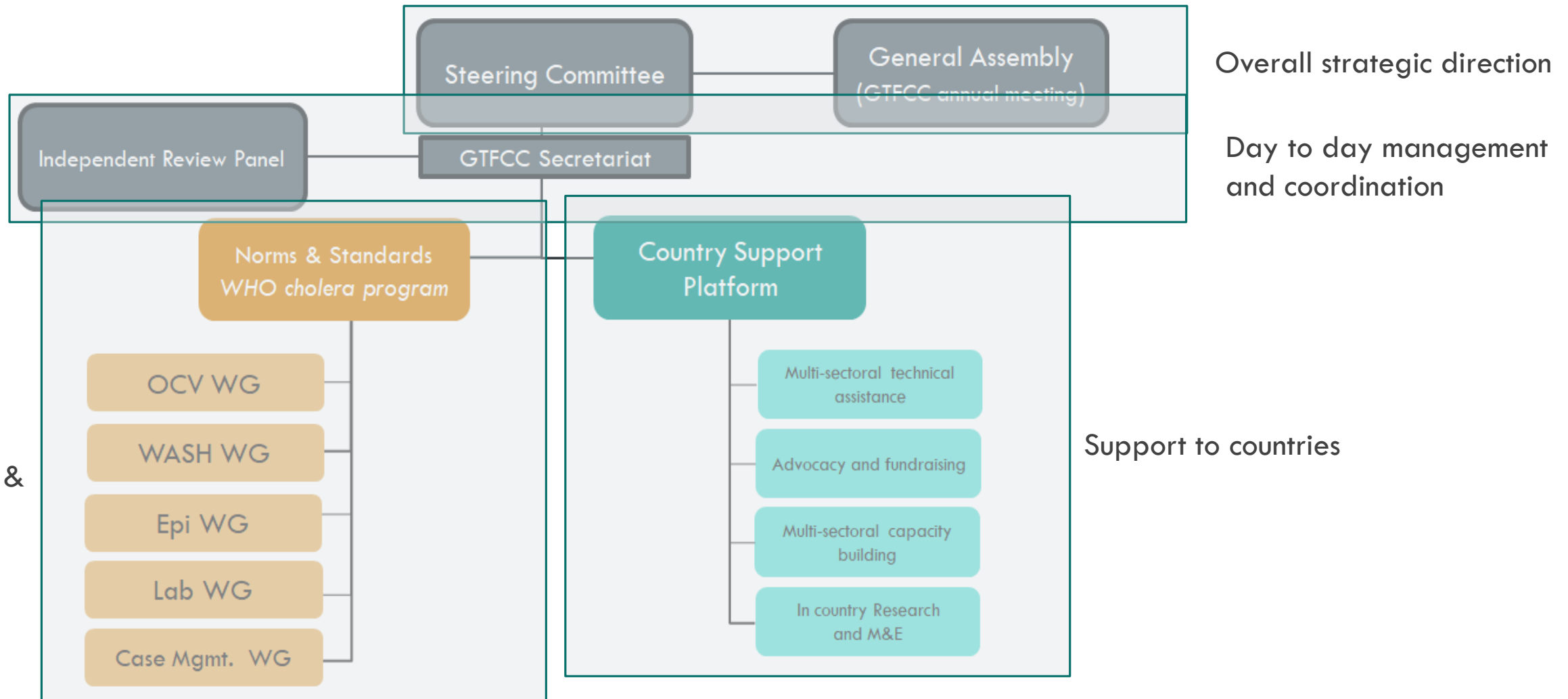
# GTFCC GOVERNANCE TODAY



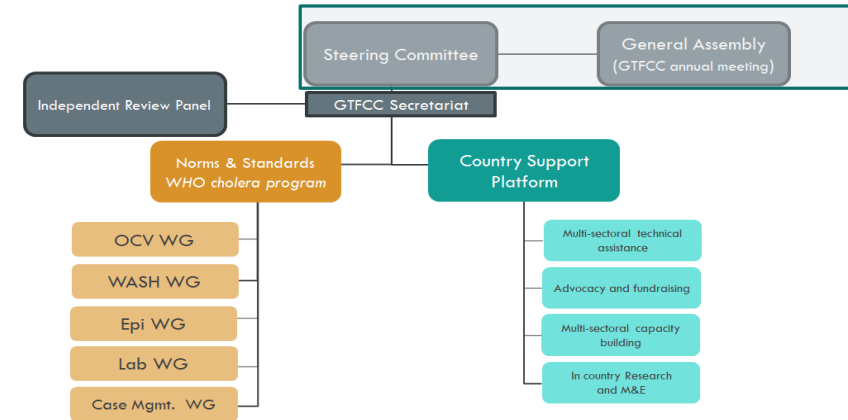
## RATIONALE FOR MAKING THE COORDINATION AND LEADERSHIP MECHANISMS MORE ROBUST AND BETTER STRUCTURED

- The multi-sectoral nature of cholera control calls for robust mechanisms of coordination at the global and country level
- Supporting countries for the implementation of the *Roadmap* as one the key role of the GTFCC
  - TORs: To strengthen countries' capacity to prevent and control cholera, especially those related to implementation of proven effective strategies and monitoring of progress...
  - WHA 2018 resolution 71/A71
  - GTFCC annual meeting 2018
- The *Roadmap 2030* is a country driven process
  - However, without operational support at the country level, the Roadmap “runs a very high risk of becoming just another strategy on the shelf” (GTFCC review, 2017)
  - Country demand for support

# OVERALL STRATEGIC DIRECTION

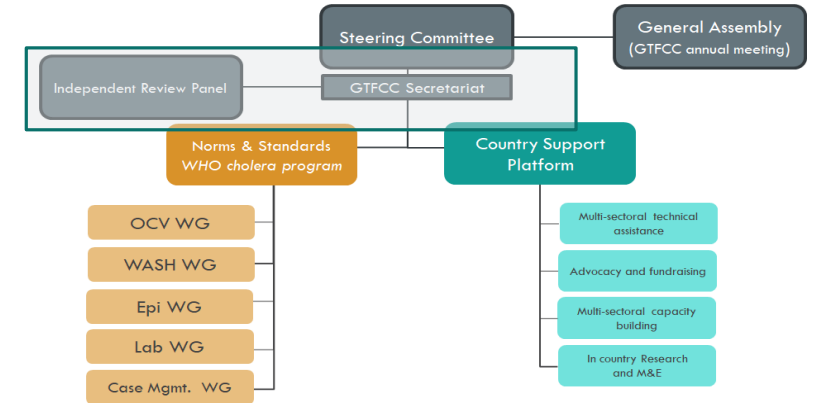


## Steering committee

- Responsible for oversight, strategic direction and accountability for the GTFCC as a whole
- Support and conduct high level advocacy at the global level
- Review the activities of the GTFCC and ensure that achievement of the *Roadmap* remains on track
- Initial members: CDC, IFRC, UNICEF, WHO, BMGF, GAVI, Bangladesh, Zambia

The annual meeting to act as a **General Assembly** for the GTFCC, an opportunity to review progress and challenges and give voice to countries

# MANAGEMENT AND COORDINATION



## GTFCC secretariat

- Works under the supervision of and reports to the Steering Committee
- Ensures coordination between the WHO cholera program and the CSP

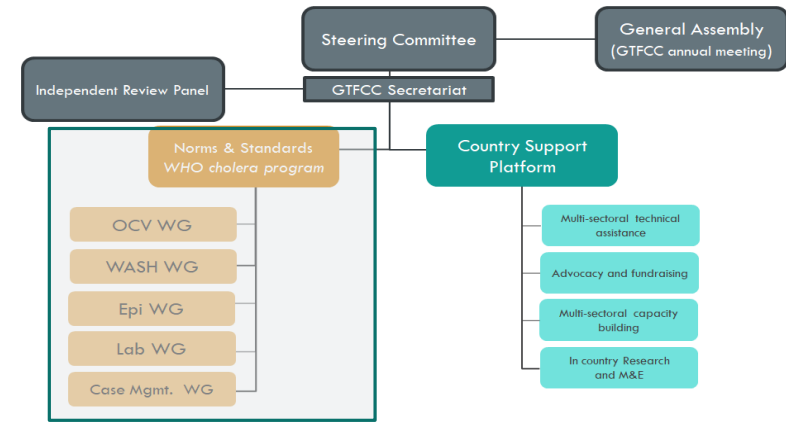
## Functions

- Monitor the implementation of the NCPs
- Develop and regularly update a global advocacy, communication and fundraising strategy
- Organize all the meetings of the GTFCC
- Ensure effective sharing of information among countries and partners at the global level

## Independent Review Panel

- An independent technical review mechanism for transparent and in-depth assessment and endorsement of countries NCPs, ensuring consistency and alignment with the global 2030 Roadmap
- Pool of experts which are GTFCC members

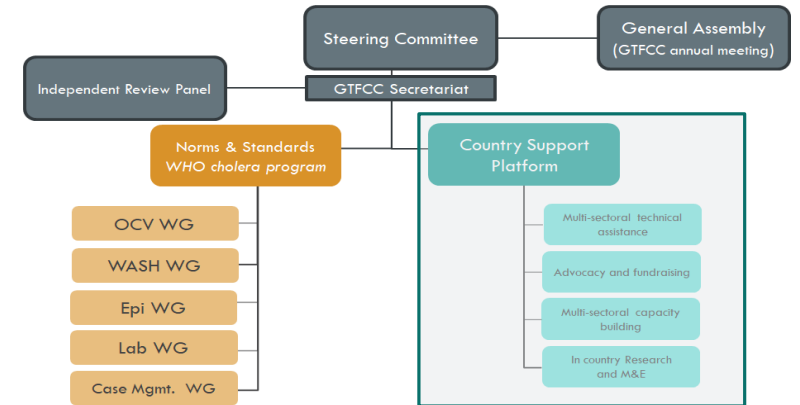
# TECHNICAL GUIDANCE & RESEARCH AGENDA



## WHO Cholera program

- Ensures effective technical leadership and sound guidance and standards development
- Coordinates the work of the various working groups
- Ensures alignment of norms and standards with those of WHO and other partners
- Coordinates the development of a cholera research agenda

# SUPPORT TO COUNTRIES



**Country Support Platform (CSP)** : the operational arm of the GTFCC

- Coordinates the support to countries for the practical implementation of their NCPs
- Functions:
  - Short, medium and long term multi-sectoral technical assistance
  - Reinforcement of surveillance capacities and supply of commodities
  - National advocacy and fundraising
  - Multi-sectoral capacity building
  - Support for the implementation of in-country research projects and M&E
- Hosted by a GTFCC partner agency

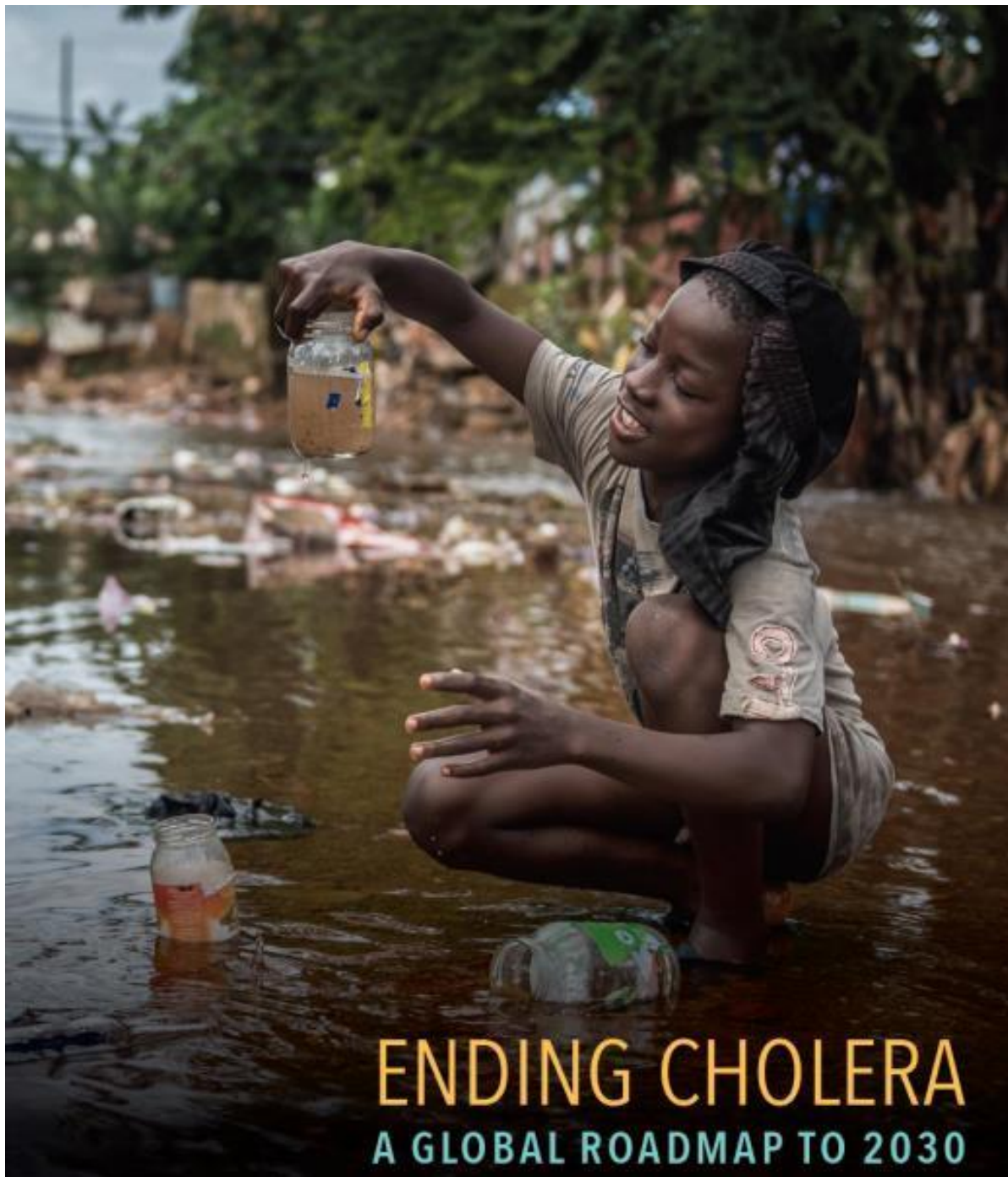
