OCV market past and present

Pre-2016

- Single supplier with programmatically suitable OCV (glass vial)
- Limited availability (< 2 Mds)
- Vaccine availability limiting activities to outbreak response

Post-2016

- Two supply sources with programmatically suitable OCVs (glass vial and plastic tube)
- Increased availability - up to ~25 Mds
- Increased availability allows the expansion of activities to include preventive campaigns

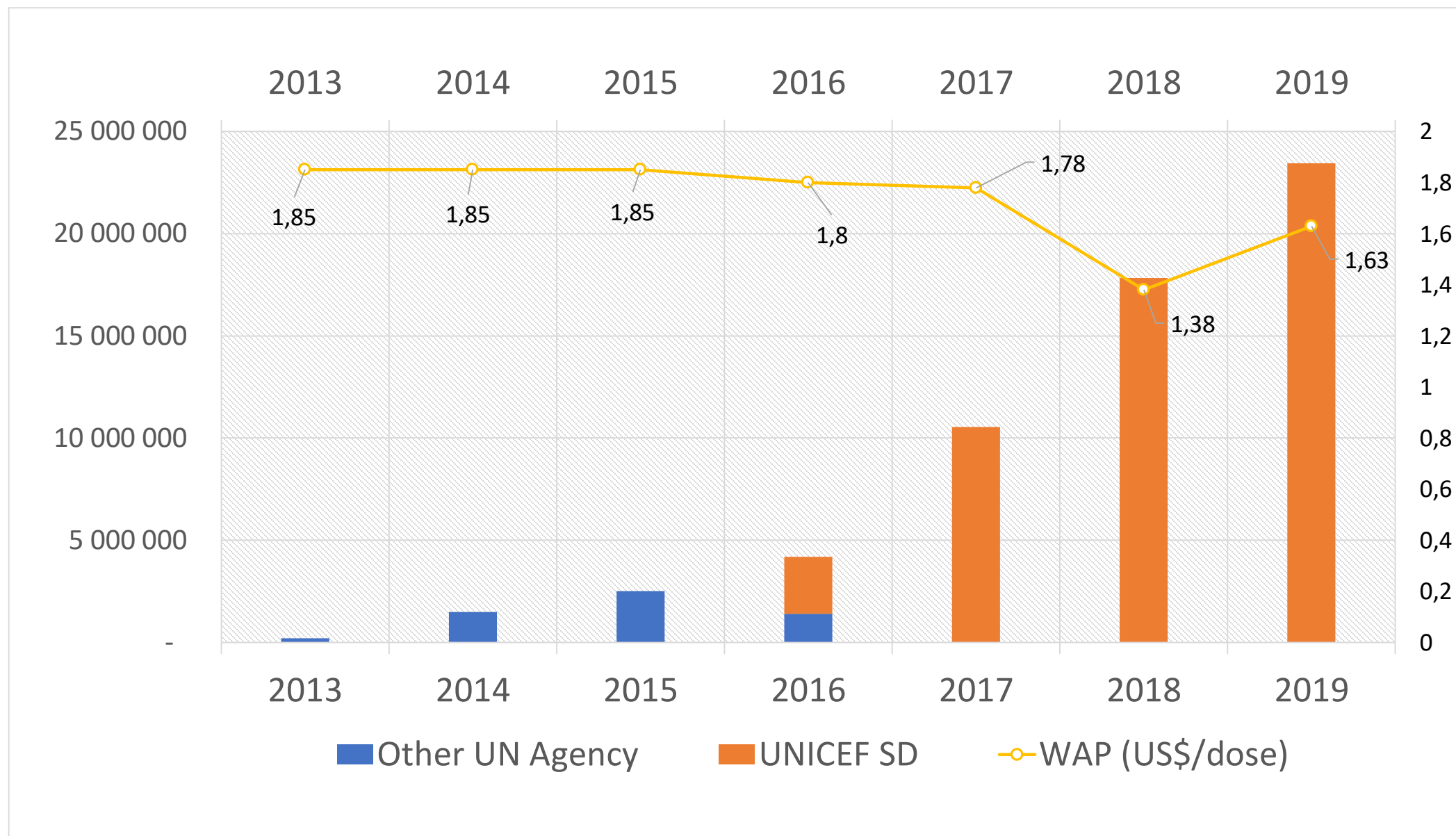


OCV supply: past & present

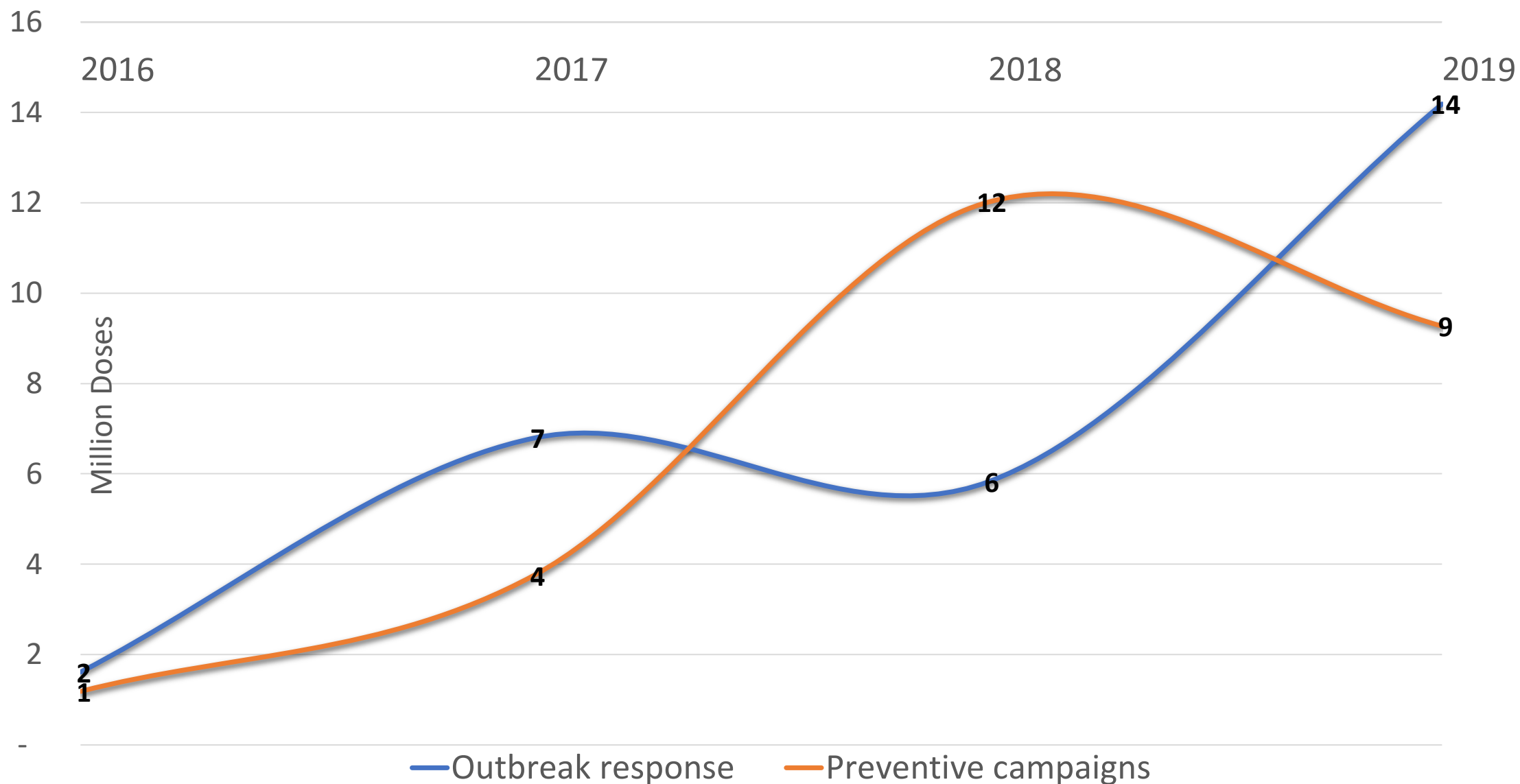
- Significant increase in supply since 2013 (8 to 10 times).
- As of today, 23.5Mds procured in 2019, representing a 32% increase in comparison to 2018 (17.83Mds).
- Availability from suppliers is increasing
- Supply to Emergency outbreak and preventive campaigns is managed as **ONE** (with different modalities for deployment)



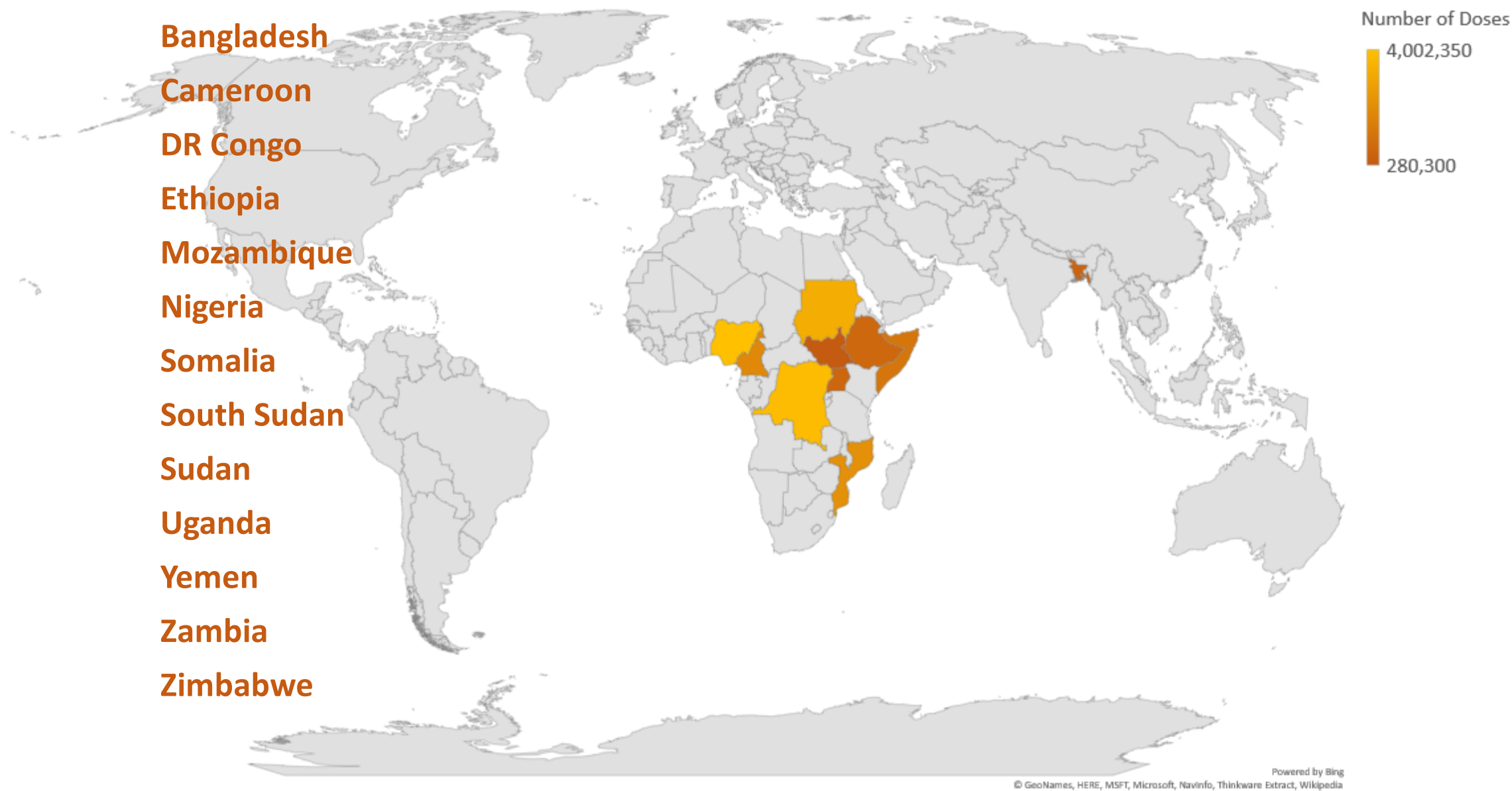

Shipment types: Preventive vs. Outbreak

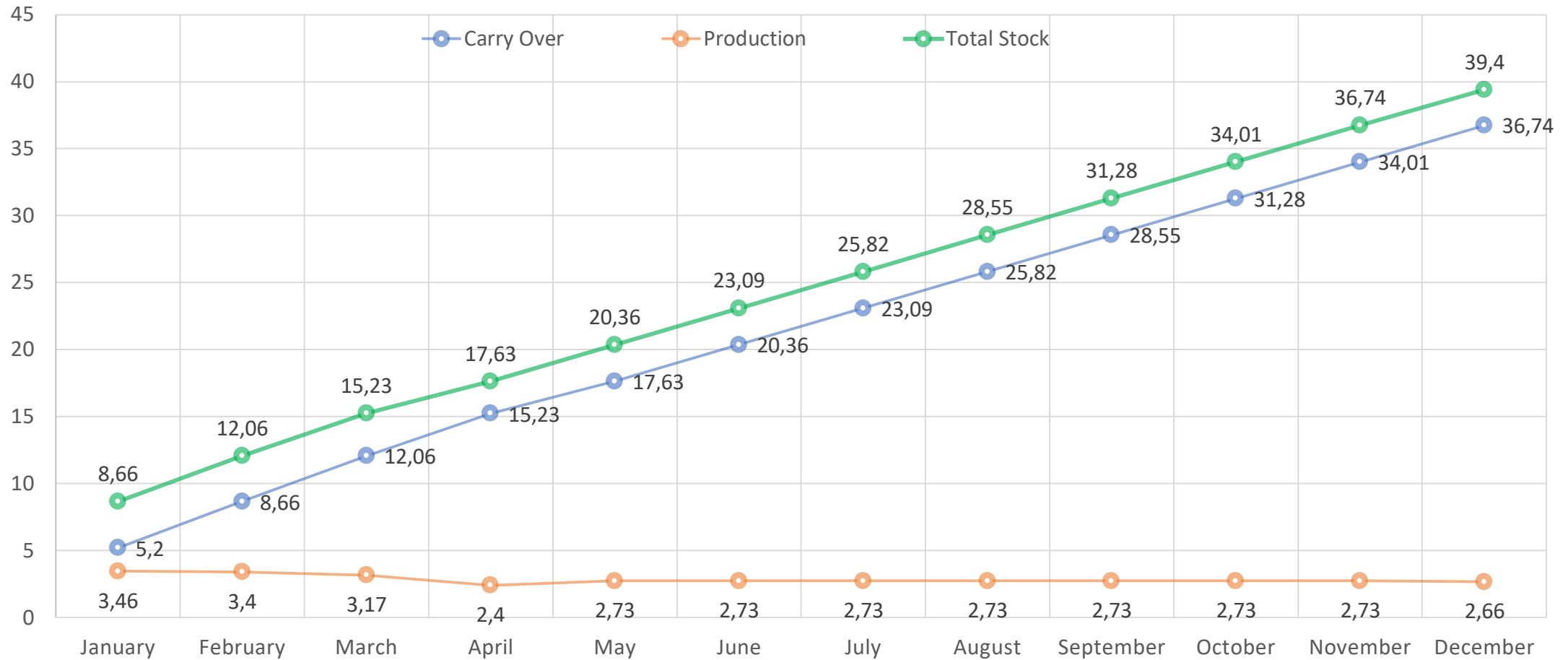


Shipment geography, 2019

OCV main considerations

- Enable increased availability through improved short- to mid-term forecasting
- Improve mechanism for assessing large multiyear requests, to increase certainty of forecast
- Outbreak response: 3 million doses “at all times”
 - OCV replenishment timeline as per production plans and available stock
 - Stock Management practices: production lead time vs shipment plans
- **ONE STOCK** for Emergency outbreak and preventive campaigns (with different modalities for deployment)
- LTAs extension 2020; Multiyear tender 2021+ following resolution of Gavi VIS

Key messages

- Increased supply with increased demand, including preventive campaigns
- Improved forecasting would improve the market healthiness.
- UNICEF working with GTFCC and Gavi to improve forecasting
- Gavi Board funding decision (June 2019) allowed for working on LTAs extension for 2020, while awaiting VIS decision
