



HPV girls vaccination programme in Ireland

- Started in 2010
- School based programme, 2 then 3 doses
- 12-13 year old girls (~30,000)
- Parents sent information leaflet, consent form and contact details for school teams
- Referred to website <u>www.hpv.ie</u> for more information
- Uptake 81-89% from 2010-2015



What happened?

- Concerned parent groups formed
- Local and national media printed articles raising concerns
 - About vaccine safety
 - That HPV vaccine caused serious side effects
- TV programme aired
- Very active on social media








Free Sourced Information on HPV Vaccine for Parents in Ireland

parents to vaccinate or not vaccinate their shild. Your decision is your obside.






Actions: Spoke to Parents




Health Minister supports launch of campaign


