

Country Context

- 80% of population rural/ underserved
- 20% of population live > 5 kms away from the nearest health facility
- Majority of deaths from malaria/ diarrheal/ respiratory diseases
- Efficacious interventions not readily available – lack of community participation

Promising Social Solutions

 Chipatala Cha Pa Foni (CCPF) – A mobile-health solution providing a toll free hotline to gain health advice from nurses as well as health tips and reminders via SMS and voice messaging



 Kaundu Community-Based Health Insurance – A community-initiated and owned health insurance scheme that reduces the excessive health service fees at a time of need



A Sustainable And Affordable Rural Healthcare System – Rural Healthcare
 Prototype – An integrated rural healthcare model comprised of a fully solar
 & wind -powered hospital complemented by vocational training and sustainable
 agriculture programmes providing employment to 300-people



 Learners Treatment Kit – trained teachers diagnosis using mRDTs and providing malaria treatment using ACTs
